- 1. Is your Product stored in suitable packaging for the transport of its contents?
- 2. Confirm the number, content & weight of your parcels or pallet.
- 3. Confirm the date & time required for the Collection & Delivery.
- 4. Clearly label the parcel or pallet with Name & Location of Collection & Name & Location of Delivery.
- 5. Confirm the Temperature your Product needs to be maintained at during Transit to Delivery.
- 6. Parking costs incurred are paid at the rate at which they are charged to our drivers this will be added to your Invoice.
- 7. London Congestion Zone if your Transit passes through the zone a £15 cost will be added to your Invoice.
- 8. Dangerous Goods? These must be declared before in writing PUKKA will then decide if the item can be transported. Documentation relative to transportation of the Goods must accompany the Goods.
- 9. Confirm your Products are Insured for Transit against loss & damage.
- 10. Regular clients can apply for a credit account & pay their invoices to standard 15 days terms, subject to credit status.

Other Key Points For Your Delivery

WAITING TIME & CANCELLATION

For Van Collection - 20 minutes is given Free of Charge - following this waiting time is then charged at £20 p/ additional 20 minutes or part thereof. The Client will be contacted via text or called by the Courier - if the Client cannot be reached & the wait time goes beyond 40 minutes - the job is deemed to be cancelled & a 50% charge of the total job fee will be made to the Client.

For Van Deliveries if the wait time goes beyond 40 minutes - the Goods will be taken to the PUKKA Warehouse & stored, to be charged at the rate of £20 per pallet & £10 per parcel - per 24hr period or part thereof in increments of 12 hrs.
